CALF SCHOLARSHIP

The purpose of the Calf Scholarship Award Program is to select a youth who is worthy of the award - a Registered Holstein calf with the potential to develop into a future brood cow. The program offers such a calf to a youth who has demonstrated the interest and ability to develop the calf to her fullest potential and who will grow through this project.

Applicants for this award must meet the following specifications:

1. Age limit -- 12-15 years of age (as of January 1, 2022).
2. Housing facilities - youth must have the facilities to raise a calf, must live or work on a working dairy farm including milking facilities, and the herd must be on or be willing to participate in official test and classify, when the animal freshens and is eligible to participate in these programs. The calf must be housed in New York State.
3. Junior Holstein membership -- applicants do not necessarily have to be Junior members, but must be willing to join the New York Junior Holstein Association. Applicant must be a resident of New York State. **Juniors who have previously applied and not been selected to win the calf are welcome to resubmit an application.**
4. Farm visits -- youth must welcome periodic farm visits.
5. Show calf -- winner must be willing to show the calf at appropriate shows.
