

COUNTY SCRAPBOOK CONTEST RULES

1. All entries must be brought to the convention in January.
2. Scrapbooks should contain only events from the past year.
3. Scrapbooks will be judged on content, organization, originality and neatness.
4. There will be awards for the top three entries.

FOLDING DISPLAY CONTEST RULES

1. All entries must be set up for display at the State Junior Holstein Convention.
2. Displays should be free standing and fit on a table top, and **must not** exceed 48" in length or 48" in height. Any additional props or stands will not be judged.
3. Displays will be judged on content, organization, originality and neatness.
4. Winners will be announced at the State Junior Holstein Convention.
5. There will be awards for the top three entries in each division.

Divisions:

- Junior: 9 to 13 years old as of January 1
- Intermediate: 14 to 17 years old as of January 1
- Senior: 18 to 21 years old as of January 1
- County Division

SCORING FOR JUDGING SCRAPBOOKS & FOLDING DISPLAY

CONTENT - 40 Points

- Variety of Holstein related activities
- Activities outside the Junior Holstein Club (scrapbook only)
- Pictures and clippings of events
- Information about officers, awards, etc.

ORGANIZATION - 30 Points

- Arranged in such a way that the story portrayed can be followed easily and logically.

ORIGINALITY - 15 Points

- Creativity
- Club's use of new ideas

NEATNESS - 15 Points

- Pages bound neatly and securely in an attractive, durable cover (scrapbook only)
- Pictures and clippings securely fastened
- Captions neatly written
- Display sturdy, durable and attractive

TOTAL OF 100 POINTS. Entries for both the Scrapbook and Folding Display Contests should be brought to the New York State Junior Holstein Convention for judging. The information included in both scrapbooks and folding displays should include only the current year's activities.
